After School Activities Program

Fall 2019

- Our Fall session begins the week of October 7, 2019. The Robotics Club begins September 16th.
- Student absences cannot be made up or refunded. In the event of a school closure due to inclement weather, or a program teacher's absence, one make-up class will be held at the end of the session.
- At 3:25 pm, Kindergarten-8th grade students will be offered a snack provided by the program. At 3:45 p.m., students will be picked up by the clubs presenter and escorted to their clubs classroom.
- Parent pick-up for Kindergarten-8th grade students is at 4:45 p.m. in the main hallway. There will be a \$15 fee billed for pick-ups after 4:45 p.m.
- Kindergarten-8th students may stay for After School Child Care for no additional fee if prior plans have been made.
- Preschool clubs will begin at 2:55 pm and end at 3:25 pm. Parent pick-up is at the 3:25 pm dismissal time.
- Preschoolers who use After School Child Care on the same day they attend a club are subject to the appropriate After School Child Care fee.
- If a club is canceled, parents will be notified by the clubs presenter (if he/she is a Harbor faculty member) or by Miss Lange. The date for rescheduling will be given at that time.
- No club refunds are permitted, but students can apply a credit to switch to another club running during the same trimester.

The cost for each school-aged club (K-8th grade) is \$150, unless otherwise noted. Preschool clubs are \$75 and run from 2:55 pm to 3:25 pm. Some clubs have a materials fee. Please make checks payable to *Harbor Country Day School*.

Robotics Jr "Chain Reaction: Ready, Set, Roll"

See the laws of motion at work in this thrilling, hands-on course. Both new and returning participants are welcome. Students will construct machines, like the Heavyweight Hammer and the Spin-o-Matic, and then combine them to create exciting chain reactions! Each week, the chain reactions will become more complex with the introduction of new machines. The projects will afford students the opportunity to delve into concepts such as force, gravity, velocity, types of energy, and balance. At the end of the session, students will be challenged to create the Ultimate Chain Reaction by working cooperatively to see how many machines they can incorporate.
