After School Activities Program

Winter 2019

- Our winter session begins the week of January 7, 2019
- Student absences cannot be made up or refunded. In the event of a school closure due to inclement weather, or a program teacher's absence, one make-up class will be held at the end of the session.
- At 3:25 pm, Kindergarten-8th grade students will be offered a snack provided by the program. At 3:45 p.m., students will be picked up by the clubs presenter and escorted to their clubs classroom.
- Parent pick-up for Kindergarten-8th grade students is at 4:45 p.m. in the main hallway. There will be a \$15 fee billed for pick-ups after 4:45 p.m.
- Preschool clubs will begin at 2:55 pm and end at 3:25 pm. Parent pick-up is at the 3:25 pm dismissal time.
- If a club is canceled, parents will be notified by the clubs presenter (if he/she is a Harbor faculty member) or by Miss Lange. The date for rescheduling will be given at that time.
- No club refunds are permitted after the second week of each club.

The cost for each school-aged club (Kindergarten-8th grade) is \$150, unless otherwise noted. Preschool clubs are \$75 and run from 2:55 pm to 3:25 pm. Some clubs have material fees. Please make checks payable to *Harbor Country Day School*.

Students who stay after school for a club may go to After School Child Care, on the day the club meets, for no additional fee.




