Registration Process for Harbor Students Entering Kindergarten

All students entering Harbor kindergarten or public school kindergarten must be registered in the public school district in which the child resides. Below are some instructions to guide you through the process of registration.

- Please contact the registrar at your home district to set up a time to register in person, and to get a complete list of the documentation you will need to bring with you.
- Districts will ask you to bring proof of residency, which would be your deed or most recent tax bill if you own your home, or a notarized lease if you rent your home.
- Districts will also ask you to bring your child's original birth certificate with the raised seal – photocopies are not accepted.
- Districts will also ask you for a copy of your child's immunization record.

At the time you register your child with your home school district, you should also request transportation for the school year. Districts will generally transport a child to their private school within a certain distance. Every district has different limits, so please provide your district with our address for approval. **The deadline for transportation requests is April 1st.**

Finally, please fill out the BOCES textbook request form, which is necessary to have textbooks delivered to Harbor for your child. We also have the textbook request form here, but it is best to fill this out directly with your home district at the time of registration.
